- •People are getting married later. In 2022, the median age of first marriage for men was 30, and for women it was about 28.
- •The happiest marriages are between an oldest child and a youngest child.
- •In 2017, 22% of couples got married in a church, down from 41% in 2009.
- •Couples are choosing less traditional locations for wedding ceremonies, such as banquet halls, hotels, country clubs, wineries, rooftops, and museums.
- •Couples are turning to civil magistrates or loved ones who obtain credentials, rather than pastors/priests to officiant weddings.
- •Generally, people fall in love 3-4 times before marriage.
- •Having a shared faith can positively impact marital satisfaction. This is attributed to the values reinforced by religion like forgiveness and commitment.
- •Married couples who regularly attend religious services report higher levels of happiness and a lower risk of divorce compared to those who do not attend church together. This is attributed to shared values, social support, and commitment fostered by shared faith.

Meet with a new speaker once a month in the backroom of Bootlegrz. We've had all kinds of speakers in previous years. We've had first responders, business owners, etc.


