- Love Food and Organizing? We've got a perfect position for you at Zion. We're looking for a <u>Kitchen Manager</u> to organize our Wednesday night meals during the school year. Would require about 4hrs/week (flexible to do when it works for you). Duties: Planning monthly menu, grocery shopping, communication with serving teams, instructing prep-team. Our Wednesday night meals are an important ministry of Zion. We are grateful to Diana McLean who beautifully led our new Kitchen Manager position last year. - Do you play an instrument or sing? We'd love to connect you with our music ministry.
