

Continued Stewardship at Zion.

As we begin a new year, we celebrate what we've accomplished here at Zion. It is customary to focus on stewardship each fall, and we asked you to consider your participation in the church. If you responded, we thank you. If you are still thinking about it, please take a moment and submit a pledge card for 2023.

We've been talking for the past four months about connecting with our church. It was part of our fall stewardship campaign so it was tied to finances and giving. But this concept is not so much a catch phrase as it is a challenge. It is an attempt to get the people of Zion Lutheran connected into true community with the church, and in the church. And despite our best efforts, we know there are those in this congregation who don't feel loved, or that anyone cares.

What does this mean? It could mean we all need to work harder to provide opportunities for individuals and families to connect. God made us for community in church, not isolation. We grow the most when we in relationship with other believers. So, it's the responsibility of all of us to pursue that community building, to intentionally seek relationships. Sometimes it may seem a little awkward, but it's really worth it. It's worth putting yourself out there and trying to find connections with others. Church is all about relationship.

Here's some ideas: Stick around for little while after worship service and find someone to talk to, even someone you don't know well. Take a chance and talk to people you don't know. You may make a new friend. Another way: Make an effort to join a group or volunteer to be part of a committee. You could find it very easy to do, and you will find a welcoming group of people. A third idea: Offer the generosity of you. And, accept the generosity from others. Invite someone for coffee during the week. Invite people to join in on Wednesday's Food, Faith, and Family meal and worship. Ask someone to have coffee on Sunday mornings at 9:15. Purposely sit in a different place in worship and notice who is around you. An opportunity to build a relationship!
