

Greetings Zion Family ~

As we close out 2021 at Zion Lutheran Church, I find myself seeking comfort in the words of Isaiah 41:10 ~

10 So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you;

I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

Fear can be a crippling affliction and often times it is easier to do nothing than to face the fear and walk through it. But as God promised, he is with us and he WILL help us. This could not be truer than the walk we are taking right now at Zion. In the upcoming year, or more, we will need to trust in his perfect plan as we prayerfully contemplate and consider how we wish to shape our ministry moving forward. It is so very important that we take some time during this transition to really look at "where we are right now" and "where are we going". Once we have a clear idea of where we want to go, it will guide us in what we are looking for in a new Lead Pastor. This is not a fast process and at times it may seem difficult and/or daunting, but with God's promise of strength we will walk through this together.

I know that many of you wonder where we are in the call process and what actions (if any) myself, and the Council have taken to move forward. So I will summarize what has been done and what needs to be done.



Call Committee - a call committee has not yet been formed. I am asking each of you to prayerfully consider **COMMITTEE** if you would like to serve on the Committee. If it is upon your heart to do so, please reach out to Karen in the office to put your name in as a possible committee mem-

ber. Our Synod Bishop Craig Schweitzer has been to our Council meeting and met with staff to help guide us to move forward successfully during this process. It is so important that we take the necessary time to lay a solid foundation before seeking a new Lead Pastor.

> One of the things you will be hearing from me in the brief time I have left as your Council President is the state of our current financial status and our needs. The church has been running in the red for a few years, partially due to Covid, but primarily due to decreased giving. Our current ministry is underfunded and we cannot continue to operate and

Church maintain our current programming without increased giving. I know I FINANCES have just rubbed someone the wrong way by talking about money, but if I do not (which would be much easier for me to do, since I am almost done serving on the Council), then I too have contributed to the problem rather than seeking a solution. In the past month the Council had to request monies from the Trust Committee in order to meet our financial obligations. It was not an easy decision, but we were left with no other option since the contingency fund had been depleted. We are thankful

that the Trust made a motion and approved an amount of 50% of the loss of offering/ loose offering due to COVID. This amounted to a one-time gift of \$82,507.50 to keep us solvent through the end of the year; however, this was only approved because of the unusual circumstances of Covid. Our main goal as a Council this year is to create a balanced budget, which means that the budget will be based on pledged monies from intent cards turned in. This is why intent cards turned in are critical to budget forecasting.

Zion Lutheran Church is completely funded, in every aspect, by us - the congregants. We do not receive any money from outside resources. As a Council, we have and will continue to make every effort in reducing any controllable expenses, but that alone is not enough. I was disheartened to find out that we lost \$7500 of the Challenge money during our Stewardship Campaign because we did not successfully get 175 intent cards turned in by the end of November. How many times have you given during a certain time period, or to a certain cause, because there were "matching funds"? Unfortunately, we could not even secure "matching funds" for our own church. We must not forget that we are a steward of all God has given us ~ time, talent, health, AND finances. I am asking you to prayerfully consider how you can financially support the ministry of Zion.

I am happy to report that Bishop Craig has put me in contact with a potential interim Pastor. I will be meeting with this Pastor in the upcoming weeks and am hopeful that we will be a good fit for each other. In the meantime, Pastor Natasha helped secure Pulpit Supply through the Holidays and into January. Please remember Pastor Natasha and all the staff in your prayers as they are in a period of uncertainty as well.



We are in desperate need of worship assistants in all areas! Where can you plug in? We need ushers, communion servers, readers, and many other areas of help. Please go to the Zion website and look under <a href="Worship Assistants or click here">Worship Assistants or click here</a> to see when, where, and how you can plug yourself in. I know that I was reluctant to serve when I first started attending Zion because of that "fear thing". My brain came up with all sorts of justifications and reasons why I should not even consider helping like: "What if I cannot pronounce a word or name correctly in the

reading?" or "I am not Christian enough to serve communion." and many other FEAR based reasons. I am inviting YOU (yes, you that are reading this right now) to come serve with us. Your gifts, whatever they may be, are meant to be shared!

Thank you for the support, kind words, and prayers that you have given to myself, the Council, Pastor Natasha and the staff at Zion!
